Climate Chaos in the South is indeed another film about climate change, but this one is about people, not polar bears or glaciers. The victims in the South (Ecuador, Burkina Faso, Togo, Bangladesh) explain how their livelihoods are threatened because the seasons have a mind on their own: downpours and cyclones destroy all that stands, droughts scorch the earth, rising sea levels are reclaiming land and drinking water is sparse. International experts (such as Lord Nicholas Stern, Michael Gorbachev, Pavan Sukhdev and Jean-Pascal van Ypersele) sketch the broader context. What originally appeared to be purely an environmental problem is only the beginning of an unimaginable humanitarian catastrophe. That something has to be done to mitigate climate change is obvious, but that the South will also have to adapt is inevitable. Meanwhile, hundreds of thousands leave their home, in search of viable places to live...
