Original title: Cobain

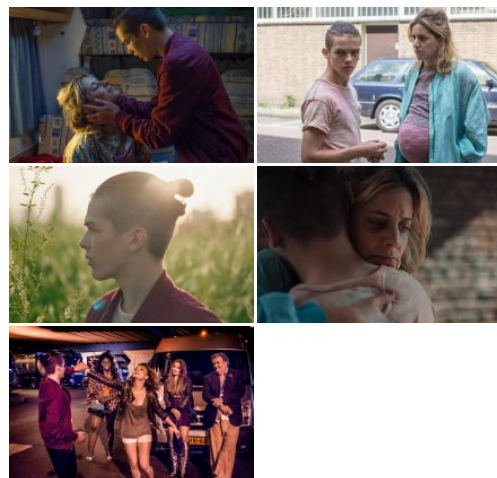
