Original title: Hit Him on the Head with a Hard Heavy Hammer

The starting point for *Hit Him on the Head with a Hard Heavy Hammer* is a handwritten memoir by the filmmaker's father, recounting his experience of displacement during wartime. Referring to Thomas Hardy's notion of the 'self-unseeing', set out in an eponymous 1901 poem, the film returns to childhood and the matters that harden us: upbringing, social status, education, labour, and familial bonds. The memoir weaves into the film as both a contemplation of mortality and an illustration of fading memory, reflecting on how we pen our pasts and how they can be re-told.

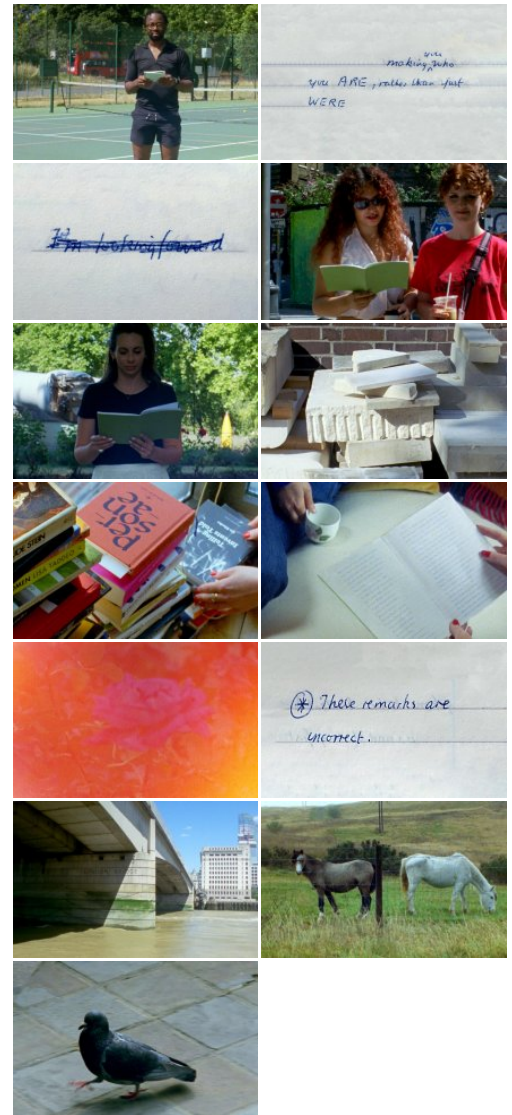
