The film investigates the myth of photography at the beginning of the 20th century, with a heavy focus on materiality courtesy of its 16mm reversal stock, hand-developed by its director, Vito A. Rowlands. It wants to be discovered as a forgotten film, lost to time in a suitcase that may have belonged to Jean Epstein, Germaine Dulac, or Carl Theodor Dreyer.
