Lobi, meaning both 'yesterday' and 'tomorrow' in Lingala, is an experimental visual essay on the 50th anniversary of the Democratic Republic Congo's independence. Nine young filmmakers of Congolese and Belgian origin collaborated in Kinshasa to create this Super8 film, expressing nine different views that merge into a quest for a common language to broach the past, conceive the present and imagine the future.
