Lost Down Memory Lane, a documentary by Klara Van Es, is a slice-of-life set in Iduna, an apartment house where eight ageing women with dementia share their disease and their lives. Alzheimer's hasn't overruled all their mental abilities yet: they are scientifically speaking in the first phase of the disease, which means that flurries of lucidity, oblivion and absence take turns continuously. They are, in their own way, perfectly capable of telling and showing what losing your memory really is about. Their life, though on the edge of consciousness, goes on.
