In the 1990s, women left Moldova in large numbers to provide for their families. Unable to return home, they found a way to stay in touch: sending cardboard boxes filled with gifts you could only dream about in those days. In return, their children would send videotapes. This exchange became a ritual among many families. Through the intimate images of these video cameras, the film depicts the fragility of family bonds seen by a generation of mothers and daughters who were forced to live apart. While doing so, the film portrays a post-Soviet country caught at a crossroads of history. A country whose women were unwittingly put in charge of making the transition from communism to capitalism.
