

Meeting at the Seaside

Original title: Rendez-vous à la mer

A poetic short film about Fritz's dying process. The film develops as a thought, a sigh, a poem. Fritz wakes up on his deathbed by the sea, where he receives the last cleansing by his beloved, Ulrich. An endless now-moment carries the ritual in which they say farewell to each other. The changing image formats allow the viewer to move between the subjective experience of Fritz and real time. This blurs the boundaries between inside and outside, present, past and dream. Just like Fritz experiences his world passively, the audience gets no explanation of interpretation of the different characters who come along. The absence of dialogue and the sudden ending leave the viewer with a cinematic experience.
