Sammy's Adventures - The Secret Passage is the story of a sea turtle from hatchling to maturity. Only one in a 1,000 turtles makes it to adulthood, but for Sammy the odds seem even worse. About half the size of the other hatchlings, he can barely make it out of his nest alone. It takes a sea turtle 30 to 50 years to reach maturity, at which point they return to the beach where they were born to reproduce. This epic journey starts in 1959 and Sammy spends the first 10 years of his life drifting on the ocean currents with his friend Ray. Hurt in a fishing incident, he is picked up by a small boy and spends several months as the mascot of a hippie commune on a Californian beach. He then decides to travel the world looking for a girlfriend from his childhood years...
