The film attempts to find some perspective on the question of what is self and what is other; what emotions lie behind inner and outer struggle; and what drives mankind to make fatal sacrifices.

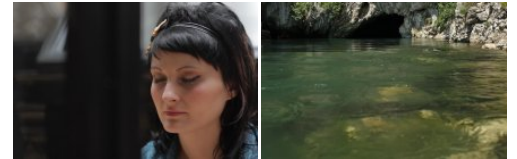
