A three-part experimental documentary exploring cultural identity in both Belgium and Bosnia-Herzegovina. The solitary reflections of a female Bosnian are explored alongside interviews with people still living there and those who fled the country during the civil war. The film attempts to find some perspective on the question of what is self and what is other; what emotions lie behind inner and outer struggle; and what drives mankind to make fatal sacrifices.
