Sœur Sourire is based on the life of a fascinating historical figure: Jeannine, a young Belgian girl who joined the convent and became a star in 1961 when she composed and sang the hit 'Dominique'. The tragedy experienced by this young woman, who adopted the stage name Sœur Sourire (aka The Singing Nun) has everything to do with lack of love. Life in the convent proved hard for the passionate Jeannine, but also gave her moments of joy she had never enjoyed before. She composed 'Dominique', which the church then used in an attempt to rejuvenate its waning image. The song became a worldwide hit.

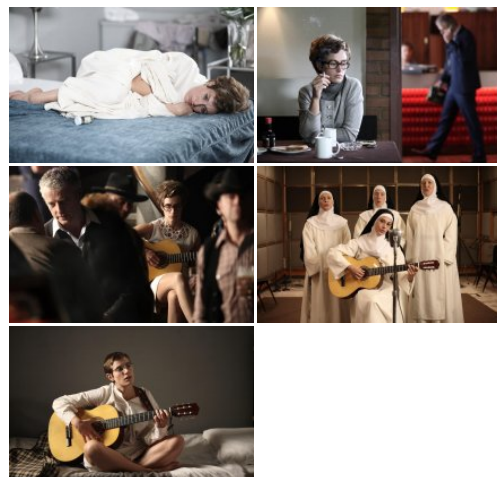
