Original title: Slave Island

A film that reveals the existence of present-day slave trade on Sumba island in Indonesia. While investigating human trafficking, local activist Jeremy Kewuan meets a Maramba shaman who believes in his ancestral right to slave ownership. Amidst this, an 8-year-old enslaved girl emerges. Traditionally, the Ata people should serve the Maramba masters for generations and, upon death, be buried with their masters. Through a myriad of confrontations with slave owners, chieftains, and his own beliefs... Jeremy eventually secures freedom for the young slave girl. A small victory for the fight against human abuse while the Queen of the island still owns hundreds of slaves that await emancipation.
