

# The Books He Didn't Burn

Original title: Die Bücher, die Hitler nicht verbrannte

Adolf Hitler owned 16,000 books at the end of his life, 1,200 of which are now kept in the Library of Congress in Washington DC. American historian Timothy Ryback has studied these books for almost a decade. This documentary about Ryback's work shows the extent to which the racist and antisemitic ideas in these books, often bestsellers long before the Nazis took power, paved the way for Hitler and continue to have a strong influence on Western thought.
