In 1955, 60-year-old Marcel Pagnol is an acclaimed playwright and filmmaker. Realising his memory is failing him, and deeply affected by the disappointing results of his last two plays, Pagnol starts to doubt his ability to pursue this work. Together, they explore Marcel Pagnol's incredible history, and bring back to life his most cherished encounters and memories.
