Original title: De vreemde man

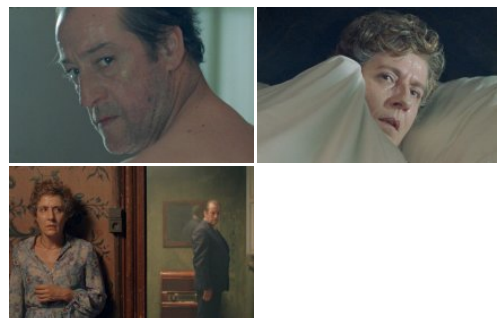

In utter despair and anxiety she kills that man who has entered her house. *The Strange Man* is a poetic evocation of the process of alienation and the human anxiety for 'Das unheimliche'.
