Original title: Tracking the Subject

Tracking the Subject is an audiovisual 360°-surround installation that sets out to confront the audience with the sensorial memories of migrants experienced during their 'illegal' journey towards Western Europe. The work presents a subjective counter narrative of the human being, too often lost and left invisible in both quantitative and trauma-reductive media perspectives. As a point of departure, the work draws on in-depth interviews with five people about their journey to Western Europe. The majority of the video recordings were shot along the refugee-route in South Eastern Europe with a panoramic surround camera. The sensorial impressions are given shape through different audiovisual registers: documentary footage, re-enactments and CGI.
